Worship Team Guidelines

Dress Code

- **Hats:** Vocalists are not permitted to wear baseball caps or any headwear that obscures their eyes. Beanies are acceptable.
- **Modesty:** Please choose attire that reflects modesty. Avoid clothing that exposes the midriff, is see-through, or is overly tight.
- No Shorts: Shorts are not permitted on stage.
- **Graphic Tees:** Non-offensive graphic tees are acceptable, as long as they align with the values of the team and do not distract from worship.

The goal is to ensure that our focus remains on worship and not on what we're wearing.

Stage Etiquette

Stage presence plays a role in leading worship. Please keep these points in mind:

- Chewing Gum: Please refrain from chewing gum during rehearsals or services.
- **Awareness:** Be mindful of your position and movement on stage. Avoid turning/keeping your back to the congregation unnecessarily.

Our role is to draw attention to God, not ourselves. Please avoid any actions or behaviors that may distract from worship. If you're unsure about something, consider this: Does it help or hinder the congregation's focus on God?

Conduct

As representatives of the worship team, our attitudes and interactions matter.

- Be punctual for rehearsals and services.
- Come prepared, having practiced your parts in advance.
- Maintain a spirit of kindness and encouragement

Communication: Communicate clearly and in a timely manner regarding your availability for scheduling. If adjustments are needed, let the team leader know as soon as possible.

Feedback: Be open to feedback and willing to work as a team to foster an environment of trust and collaboration
